Dr. Trotter presented this case for resolution. Dr. Trotter reviewed this case, and found that Dr. "F" did indeed breach the standard of care by not doing bloodwork on canine patient. Dr. Trotter is recommending a Consent Agreement, Private Reprimand and a \$500.00 Administrative Fine. Along with the Consent Agreement Dr. Trotter wants a Letter of Concern to be sent to Dr. "F" stating that in the future bloodwork needs to be performed on patients, especially geriatric patients, when amikasin and gentamicin is given.

Dr. Trotter presented this case for resolution. Dr. Trotter reviewed this case, and found that Dr. "G" did not breach the standard of care that was given to the patient, and that there was no violation to the Practice Act. Dr. Trotter recommends dismissal with no further action to be taken by this Board.

Dr. Edit made a motion to accept Dr. Trotter's recommendation that this case be dismissed with no further action to be taken by this Board.

Mrs. Pett seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved by the Board.

Case: # 14-TCB-661

* Filed by Case # in the Complaint Files.

Dr. Branch presented this case for resolution. Dr. Branch reviewed this case, and found that there were violations to the Practice Act, with unlicensed assistants euthanizing animals when the DVM or LVT were not on the Premises. DVM was not aware of the violations to the Practice Act, and is making sure that the facility is being permitted as a RAEF, and that the unlicensed individuals are receiving CET Certification, to become in compliance. Dr. Branch is recommending at this time a Letter of Concern regarding what an unlicensed assistant is and is not able to do by Alabama Law. This Board is to assist the RAEF & CET's to come into compliance.
